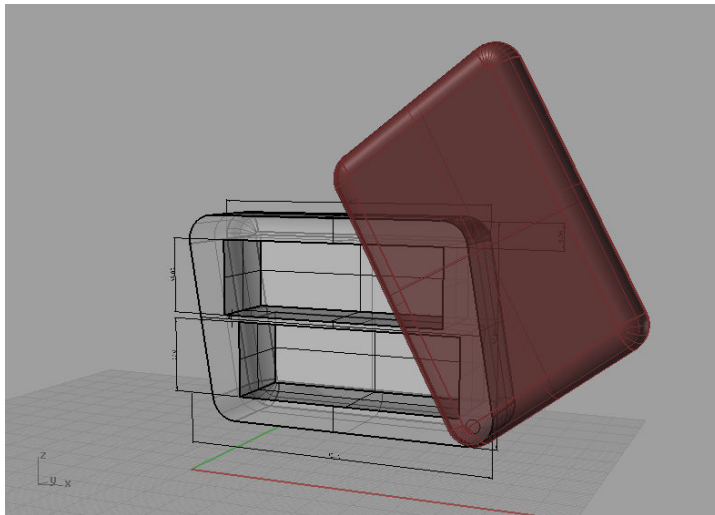


Hi Folks!

I apologize for the delayed update – things got very, very busy, and then our designer fell ill with the stomach flu (been going around the island for quite a while now). We had to quarantine him – it knocked him out for a week and but he just texted me saying he’s “*just about back in the saddle. Hope to be at full speed within a day or two*”. In the meantime, there are a few quick items to report:

He’s made a few changes to the basic body design; one will eliminate weak points in the door joints and lessen the chance of breakage if (when!) they’re dropped. Here’s a sneak peek ...



He was afraid of stresses at the joint but the new design actually takes care of it (more on that later – there’s a couple pieces missing from the model).

We also discovered that, with the original on-off switch (which is much heavier duty than average), it took too much force to easily activate it. Luckily we were able to locate the same HD switch with a lower force rating, so now we’re waiting for those parts to arrive.

Like everyone else, we’re also anxiously awaiting delivery of the “Kick”™ (Brandon told us today we’re going to get the Kick beta this week!). So we are going to wait until we’ve tested it before going into production with our main 18500 mod line. Sorry for the delay but we really want to be able to offer models with variable power selection from the get-go.

A note about materials we use: turns out sterling silver is not only beautiful, it’s anti-bacterial! Nice feature on a device that’s “hand-to-mouth” all the time. And another reason we love to use it on our products.
